



# Fire Safety First

Prevent fires, protect our community

## Minimize fire risks

- Secure areas: lock dumpsters, bins, vacant properties and outbuildings.
- Improve surveillance: enhance lighting and monitoring to deter suspicious activities.
- Report concerns: immediately report any fire safety issues to the Fire Prevention Bureau at 403-320-3811.

## Reduce fire hazards

- Dispose properly: remove excess materials including recycling, waste and pallets.
- Store safely: keep combustible materials at least 3 metres from buildings.
- Secure flammables: store flammable liquids and gases properly.

## Regular checks & maintenance

- Inspect heating systems: regularly check and maintain equipment to prevent issues.
- Code compliance: have all electrical and heating systems inspected to ensure they meet code requirements.
- Annual inspections: ensure fire alarm and life safety systems are professionally inspected.
